Limited opportunities to:

- to extend spoken & written language beyond school
- to access outdoor resources which aids physical fitness
- to access outdoor educational opportunities
- to access to reading materials outside of school
- to extend reading beyond the classroom and school
- to extend mathematical skills in real life situations

(iii) How you'll spend Pupil Premium to overcome barriers and the reasons

- Proportion of salary of Higher Level Teaching Assistant targeted support
 - Continuation of 1st class interventions to support writing
 - Leading social speaking groups

Reason: offer wider range of opportunities to extend language skills
- Proportion of salary of Teaching Assistant Posts to support maths across school
 - Continuation of 1st interventions to support maths

Reason: offer wider opportunities to extend and apply mathematical skills beyond the classroom
- Proportion of salary of Teaching Assistant Posts to support reading across the school
 - Continuation of Reading Intervention strategies

Reason: additional opportunities to extend reading skills
- Subsidising after school clubs - proportion of staff salary
Reason: offering opportunities to extend interests and experiences beyond school
- Subsidising school trips
Reason: Ensuring access to outdoor learning experiences
- Additional training for Teaching Assistants to enable better support in class
Reason: Maximising opportunities to make progress with learning
- Purchase of improved learning resources
Reason: ensuring access to supportive and stimulating learning resource

- Booster groups for maths and English.
Reason: maximising preparation opportunities for End of Key Stage SATs
- Continued development of the Forest Schools area
Reason: ensuring access to stimulating outdoor learning resources

(iv) How the effect will be measured

- Regular Teacher Assessment of learning and progress using school assessment system
- Further assessment by testing of mathematical and reading skills
- PP children to be focus of classroom monitoring and pupil progress meetings
