Maybe you could have a go at doing this at home, in the garden or if you are lucky you might get to go into Forge Valley to do this. In class we have been playing lots of different number games. A favourite one at the moment is underwater counting. You might like to show your grown ups how amazing you are at counting the different sea creatures.
