Topic

- Complete some research about the famous figure, Julius Caesar.
 - Create a fact file using your research.
 - Where and when was he born? Who was he? Why was he famous?

English

- Write a character description about Julius Caesar.
 - Use descriptive techniques such as, adjectives, adverbs, expanded noun phrases, similes and personification to improve your writing.
 - CHALLENGE: Can you include some direct speech that Caesar might say? Make sure to use inverted commas correctly.

Maths

- Recap your learning on fractions - <https://www.twinkl.co.uk/> has some good activities on fractions for Year 3 and it is currently FREE to set up.
- Identify how to split a shape into $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{3}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s, $\frac{1}{6}$ s and $\frac{1}{8}$ s.
- Can you investigate how to find $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{3}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s, $\frac{1}{6}$ s and $\frac{1}{8}$ s of a variety of numbers. What do you notice?

Science

- To write a short description about the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow).
- Can you set up an experiment to explore this?
