I hope you have all been enjoying the sunshine and have managed to get out and about with your families. I am looking forward to hearing all about your exciting adventures.



- In our phonics session, we have been playing odd one out. Maybe a grown up could help you collect some objects to play this game or you could use the pictures below to help you. We named each object out loud first and tried to hear the sound at the beginning of the word. Which one is different?
