The children then used small squares of coloured tissue to decorate their very own Elmer. Can you make an Elmer the Elephant of your own? You could make it as colourful as you like. You might use paint, felt tip pens or make a collage.
- In our numeracy session, we collected lots of objects to make a number line. You might collect 1 stone, 2 feathers, 3 leaves, 4 socks. I wonder what interesting objects you will use.
- We also planted some cress seeds. First of all, we drew a face on a small pot. Next we placed some damp cotton wool in the pot and sprinkled the cress seeds on the top. Hopefully when it grows it will look like green hair! I wonder how long it will grow.

I can't wait to hear about your adventures at home from this week. You could ask your grown up to put pictures in your sharing book or write about your adventures for us to share when we are together again.
