
Hello everyone,

This week, the children in nursery have enjoyed the story of 'The very hungry caterpillar' and we have been doing lots of activities linked to this theme.

- We made our own caterpillar with paint. Can you create a caterpillar of your own? You might use paint, coloured pens, beads or even stones from your garden. How long can you make your caterpillar?



- Maybe you could go on a hunt for caterpillars, butterflies or other bugs and insects. How many can you find and can you tell a grown up what you have found? Remember to handle them carefully and to put them back where you found them just in case they have an insect family close by. We did this in the Forest School area and found lots of worms, slugs, spiders and beetles.
- In the story, the hungry caterpillar ate different things during the week. On Monday he ate through one apple. On Tuesday he ate through two pears. Thinking about this story can you remember any days of the week? There are 7 altogether. How many can you remember?
