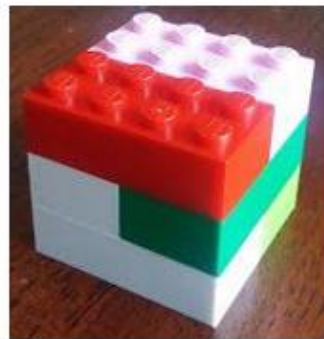

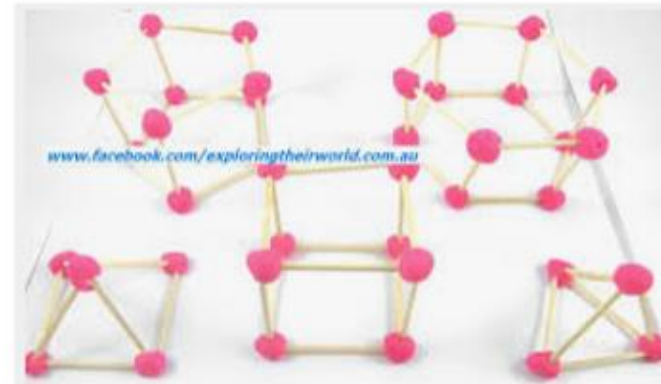

Lego

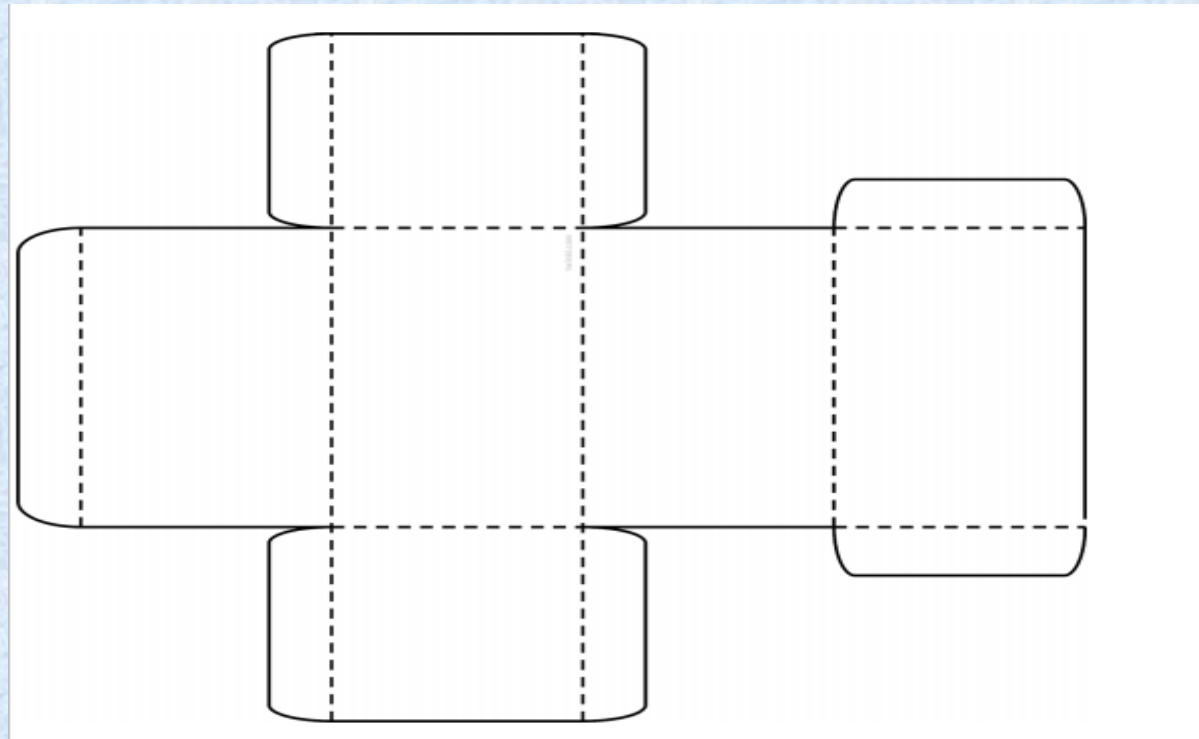


Straws

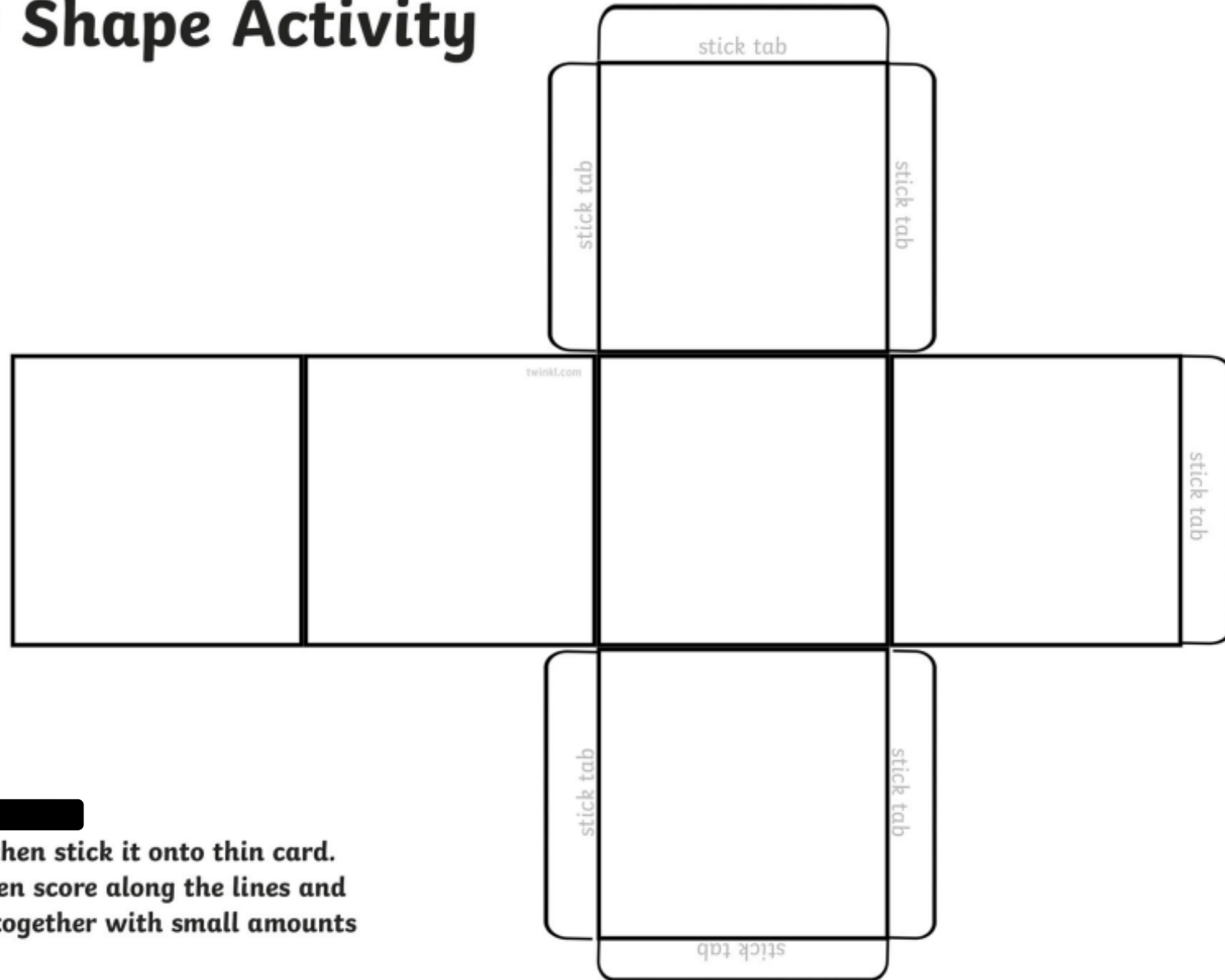
Matchsticks
