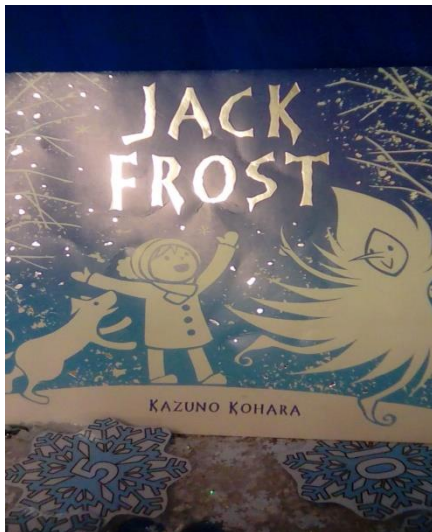


Nursery 11.01.21
