Segmenting for spelling: Quickwrite words : zip, zit, Zak, zigzag.

Can you write the question below?

Has a fox got six legs?

Can I yell?

Can he fix it?

Has a cat got a zip? yes or no?

Can you write the question in red?

Some children will need to still look at Phase 2 and others may like the challenge of the other phases.

Take your time, there is lots of work to be done in Phase 3 and children need solid foundations to build on.
