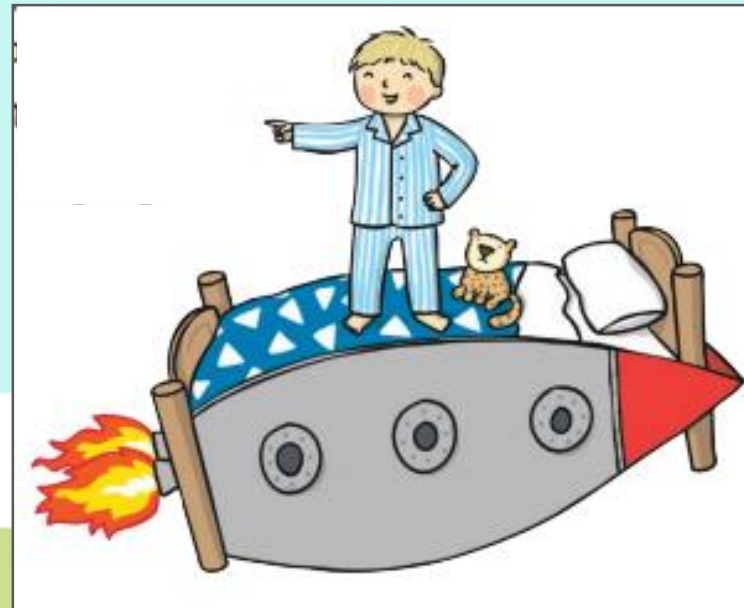

Hal has launched into space on an amazing adventure to find the Sun. Pretend you are Hal and write a postcard back home to tell everyone about your adventure.

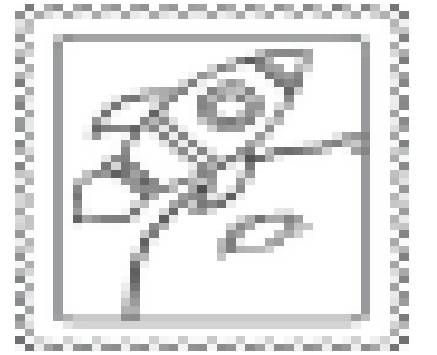
Useful Words and Phrases:
