Most importantly I would like you all to stay safe and well and I look forward to seeing you all back in Nursery as soon as we can.












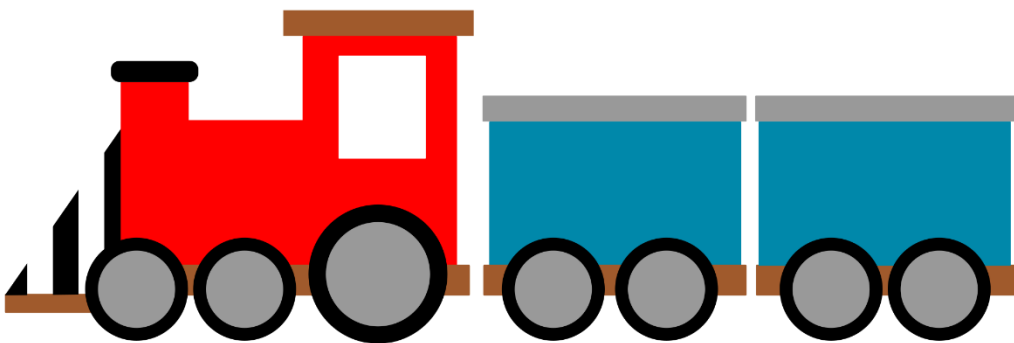
