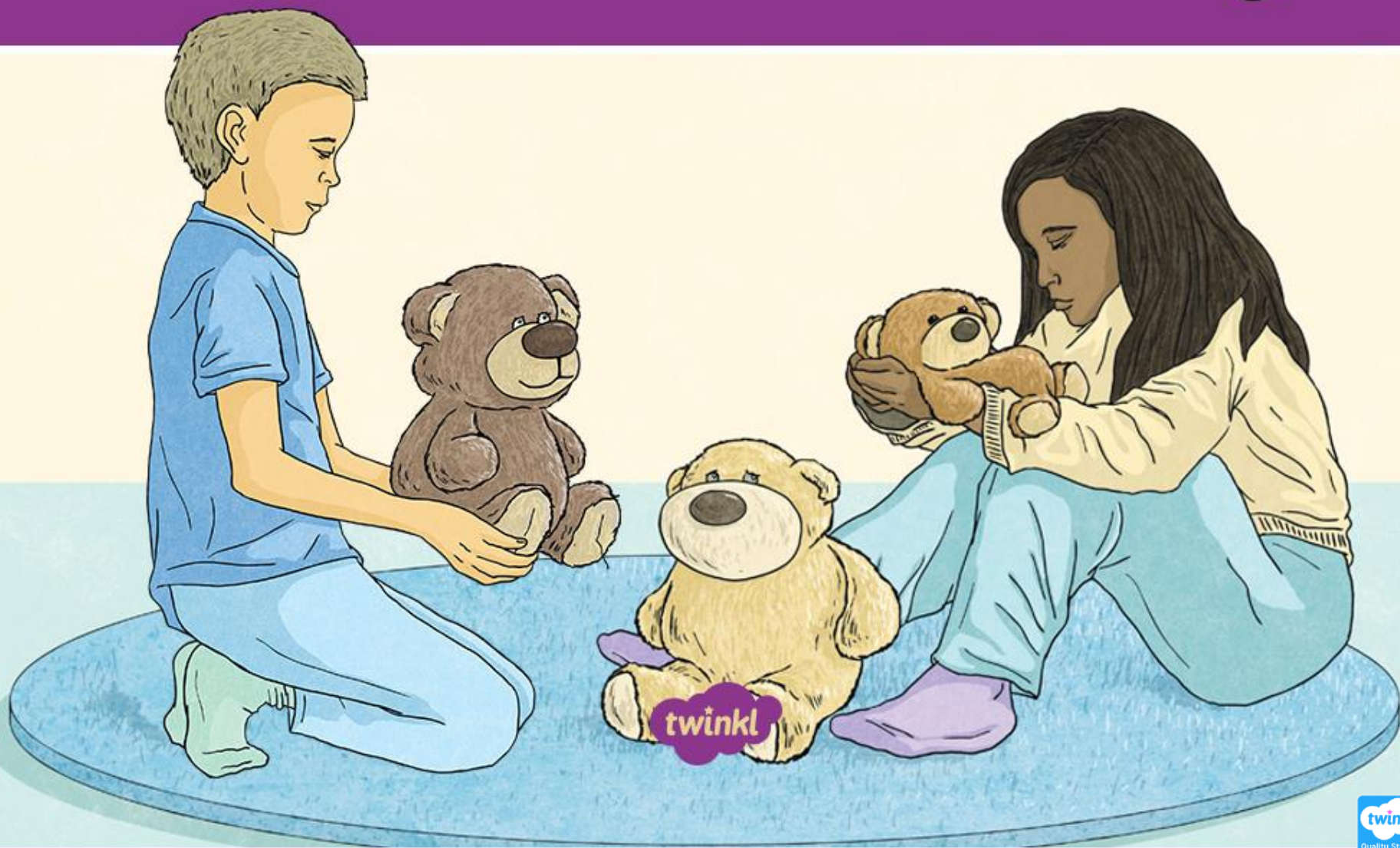

**Adults have lots of responsibilities.
Do children have responsibilities too?**



We may have responsibilities to a particular team or group. For example, if we belong to a group we have a responsibility to fulfil our role.

Responsibilities



We also have responsibilities as children. They are:

- to be the best person that we can be;
- to take care of our own bodies as best as we can;
- to look after our own belongings and respect the belongings of others;
- to learn as well as we can;
- to follow the rules at home, at school and in the community;



Responsibilities



We also have a responsibility to society.

We are all part of a wider local and global community and we have a responsibility to do the right thing by our community.

This means we should:

respect the rights of others.

care about others who are not as strong as we are, in whatever way.

stand up for our rights and the rights of others as much as we can.

The Ripple Effect



The ripple effect is the continuing and spreading results of an action.

If you think about the ripples that happen when a stone is thrown into water, where the ripples spread out into the water from the original landing point, that is the ripple effect.



The Ripple Effect



The ripple effect also happens after behaviour. This can be a negative or a positive ripple effect. What we do affects other people.

An example of this is if one person smiles at three people and then each of those three people smile at another three people, then those people each smile at three more people and so on. In this way, the ripple continues to grow and spread.
