Star Carr

- Stone Age
- Used to be a large lake in the Ice Age
- A valley in North Yorkshire
- 11,000 year old flint, red deer skulls, arrow heads and decorated pendants were found at the site.



The Gristhorpe Man

- Bronze Age
- A bronze age man who was found preserved in a tree log.
- He was found wrapped in animal skin and accompanied by a range of grave goods.
- Kept at the Scarborough rotunda museum.



Scarborough Castle

- Iron Age settlement on the headland where Scarborough Castle now stands.
- A large number of pits were found here containing bronze axes and tools, items of jewellery made of shale and bronze, material associated with bronze smelting, and a quantity of Iron Age pottery. A bronze sword was found in 1980 and two urn burials have also been uncovered.
