- Maths

Phonics

Phase 3-pupils in red group

Practise reading the high frequency words **off, can, had, back** p91–93.
Teach 'x' using phonics

Segmenting for spelling:
Phoneme frame – **mix, fix, fox, box, tax.**
Blending for reading: Matching words and pictures p87 **fox, six, box, van, jam, jet.**

Play Yes/no questions p97:
Is the sun wet?
Has the pot of jam got a lid?
Can Mum jog?

Phase 5-

Teach Homographs p143 with **bow, bow.**

Ask children to write two sentences one for each pronunciation of **bow.**

Reading sentences p142.
The window is brown.

He used his bow and arrow. The gentleman took a bow at the end of the show.
