

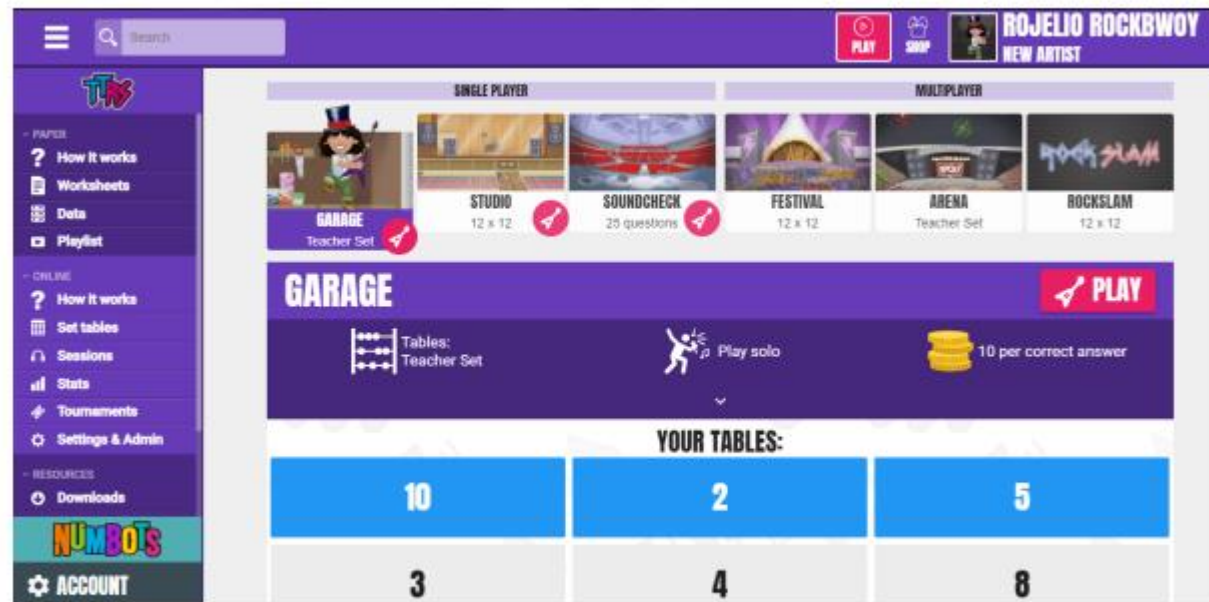

# Palm Sunday

What is Palm Sunday?

Commemorating Jesus' arrival into Jerusalem on the back of a Donkey, Palm Sunday is a Christian event that is always celebrated the Sunday before Easter. It gets its name from the palm branches that were held by the crowds that greeted him, as documented in all four canonical gospels.

# Maundy Thursday

What is Maundy Thursday?

Maundy Thursday, including the Washing of the Feet, Jesus' Last Supper with the Apostles, and Judas' betrayal of Jesus, as described in the canonical gospels.

# Good Friday

What is Good Friday?

Good Friday is an important date on the Christian calendar because it commemorates the day Jesus was crucified on the cross.

# Easter Sunday

What is Easter Sunday?

Resurrection Sunday, is a festival and holiday commemorating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. When his disciples went to check the tomb and Jesus had disappeared and risen to an angel.

# Art

## Firework Printing

### Supplies

- Black paper or card
- Paint (bright colours)
- Shallow trays or paper plates
- Bendy drinking straws
- Pipe cleaners
- Sticky tape
- Glitter



1 First, make your printing tool. To do this, gather a small bundle of about 8 straws or pipe cleaners.



2 Next, use sticky tape to tape the middle and (non-bendy) ends of the straws or pipe cleaners together to create a handle.



3 Next, bend the ends of the straws or pipe cleaners outwards to create several 'arms'.



4 Create a few firework printing tools for each different colour of paint you are going to use.



5 Next, squeeze a little paint into each tray or plate. Bright and neon colours work especially well! Then, press the 'arms' of the printing tools into the paint and press it onto your black paper.



6 Continue printing using several different colours, overlapping the colours as desired. Once the paint has dried, dab a little glue onto the fireworks and sprinkle on a little glitter.
