This week we will be looking at lots of different rhyming stories, but the main one will be 'Shark in the Park'!

We will be making our very own telescopes before going on a hunt to find objects that rhyme. You might like to hide some rhyming objects around the house or garden for your child to find. To begin with, it helps your child to recognise just one rhyming string, for example, cat, hat, mat, bat.

We have been introducing our phonics recently and we will continue with the next two sounds which are 'i' as in igloo and 'n' as in nest. You might like to listen to the Jolly Phonics songs by following this link;
