
Use a piece of wool to measure the perimeter of the hexagon. How much wool did you need? Give units with your answer.






Aisha is working out the perimeter of a rectangle.

Is it possible to work out the perimeter of each shape? Circle your answer.





How do you know whether you can or cannot find the perimeter of each shape?


