- Maths

Phonics

Phase 3-pupils in red group

Practise reading the high frequency words **off, can, had, back** p91–93.

Teach 'v' using phonics

Segmenting for spelling:

Phoneme frame p88: **van, vat, vet, visit.**

Demonstration writing p97 write the question:
Can a vet fit a jet?

Phase 5-

Teach alternative pronunciation of 'ow' p136.
Make cards for the following words: **low, grow, show, slow, bow.**

Practise spelling polysyllabic words 149: **swallow, window, grow-bag, lower.**

Reading sentences p142.
The window is low.

A continuation of Tuesday's writing the Autumn poem.

Computing

Before half-term, the children were introduced to the word 'algorithm'. They understand that it is a set of instructions. We enjoyed lots of time programming each other (using spoken algorithms/instructions) to travel around the room and collect things.

This half-term, we are going to look at recipes as a form of algorithm and will follow instructions to make (and eat) a jam sandwich.

Children Should Learn:

Why do we celebrate birthdays?

- to celebrate the birth and uniqueness of each individual
- to celebrate growth development
- Christmas is the celebration of Jesus's birthday.
- Read stories about birthdays.
- Discuss why birthdays are special and what they celebrate.
- Make a chart of class birthdays.
- Share different ways of celebrating birthdays. Bring out aspects of remembering, giving, sharing, being happy together.
- Identify aspects of birthday celebrations, which are also part of Christmas celebrations.
- Identify and share aspects of their own feelings and experiences of birthdays and of being remembered, receiving presents, giving presents, celebrating together.
- Know that Christmas is the celebration of Jesus's birthday.
