Here is some important information regarding the general outline of the school week and the expectations of the children.

Physical Education

PE lessons this year will be on Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure that your child has their full PE kit (including trainers) in school for these days. If desired, they can bring their kit in at the beginning of the week and take it home on Friday after school.

Spellings and timetables

Spelling lists will be given weekly on a Friday. Children will need to practise these spellings, the rule and a selection of tricky words, ready for their test the following Friday. They are expected to learn spelling patterns and rules in order to encourage independence in their writing.

Topic Homework

Throughout the year, your child will receive a sheet with lots of different tasks relating to the topic. These are to be completed at a time that is convenient for you and run through the entire half term.

Reading Records

Please help to foster a love of reading by encouraging your child to read at home. Reading records need to be signed at least 3 times a week and must be brought in every day. The loss of a reading record comes at the cost of £2.
