

To parents/carers,

Firstly, I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a Happy New Year. I hope you all had a fantastic Christmas. It was brilliant seeing so many of you in school in the lead up to Christmas. Whilst the Spring Term will be slightly less manic, it looks set to be another busy period in school.

In case some of you have forgotten I just wanted to remind you that the children will continue to have PE on a Tuesday and Friday. I would really appreciate if the children could have both indoor and outdoor clothing so that we are prepared for both scenarios. Children should have a plain white t-shirt, blue shorts, tracksuit bottoms and a jumper in case the weather is cold. Children are also required to have trainers in school too.

Similarly, to the Autumn Term, the children will be set homework on a Friday and will have a week to complete the activities. A typical week of homework includes ten spellings, a maths or English based task and some weekly reading. It is expected that the children read at least 3 times a week so if you could continue to sign reading records that would be appreciated. From your support at home, the children were able to make excellent progress with their reading throughout the Autumn Term so thank you.

Our new topic in school is 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. For this topic, the children will write a diary based on the perspective of a child living in the Stone Age, they will look at cave paintings and will try to recreate some Stone Age jewellery. Below is an outline of what the curriculum looks like in Class 3 during Spring 1:

Multiplication and division and length and perimeter

Art: Cave Paintings

Design and Technology: Investigation and recreating Stone Age jewellery using different materials

PSHE: It's My Body

PE: Cognitive - Dynamic Balance

French: Revision of numbers

Colours

Music: China - Pitch

Time - Beat

Computing: We are presenters - Videoing a presentation against a green screen

Religious Education: Why do people pray?
