Our history topic is very exciting and will see us learning all about the The Great Fire of London, hopefully with a visit by the Fire brigade. In Science, we will discover all the signs of Spring and will find out how the length of daylight alters throughout the year. In Computing, we will be movie makers and will attempt to make motion pictures, using all manner of devices.

There will be lots of speaking in French to learn how to tell people our name and age as well as being able to count to 10 and to know the French words for basic colours. Our music work will see us learning with Ernie, from the Stephen Joseph Theatre, who will teach us about rhythm, beat and how to use a range of instruments.
