HISTORY

SCIENCE: Plants

Introduction:

In this unit, children will learn what plants need to stay healthy. They will carry out their own investigations into what plants need to grow well and will also closely observe the inside of a seed and learn about the life cycle of a plant. They will also learn how plants look when they don't get the things they need and will learn how plants have adapted to live in different environments around the world.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

What can we learn from sacred books?

In this unit, the children will explore different Holy Books. They will look at how the books are treated and what makes them special. They will explore stories from the Torah and the Qur'an and compare different representations.

MUSIC

This half term is the unit Friendship Song.

The Friendship Song is a six-week unit focusing on this song. The material presents an integrated approach to music where games, the integrated dimensions of music (pulse rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.

PE

Physical skills/Coordination and Agility

In this unit, the children will develop and apply their sending and receiving and reaction and response through focused skill development sessions, cooperative and competitive games. They will perform a range of skills with control and consistency and perform a sequence of movements with some changes in level, direction and speed.

Art

Plant art

In this unit, the children will be altering shades by adding white or black to them and creating a replica of Van Gogh's Sunflower. Then, they will be using oil pastels and acrylic paint to create leaf rubbing and printing designs.

COMPUTING

We are animators.

In this unit, children will be creating their own animations. They will learn how animation works, use storyboards to plan an animation, create their own original characters, props and backgrounds for an animation and film and edit.

PSHE

Money Matters

This unit encourages children to think about where money comes from, the idea of spending and saving money and begin to understand why it is important to keep it safe.
