Science – Animals Including Humans

This unit focuses on the changes that human beings experience as they develop to old age. It tackles some sensitive subjects including puberty and death. They will learn about the changes experienced during puberty and why these occur. The final investigation will be about the changes to the body as humans get older, as well as comparing the life expectancy of different animals.
