Dear Parents,

This second half term is always a very busy, but exciting time in nursery as we begin our preparations for the festive period! This half term our topic is 'Terrific Tales' and the children will be enjoying a range of stories from traditional tales, festive stories and of course, The Christmas Story. We will also be focusing on lots of communication and language activities, such as retelling stories, story jigsaws and helicopter stories.

During the week, the children will have the opportunity to take part in P.E. sessions in the main school hall. These will continue to take place on a Thursday morning, and we ask that your child comes to school in sensible footwear and ask that girls wear leggings or trousers on this day.
