PE for the half-term will once again be on a Thursday morning, which will take place in the main school hall and on the school field. Comfy shoes and leggings or trousers are requested for comfort, and sunhats would be greatly appreciated (we do have spares).

We are hoping to invite parents to a junk box modelling afternoon during the half-term. This will hopefully take place in the school hall and will be a get opportunity for you to engage with our nursery team, as well as spending a fun-filled experience with your

children. We will be opening this up to our older cohort (those leaving for Reception), as our younger starters will have this opportunity with their cohort next year. More details will follow via Dojo.

Just some general housekeeping:

- Please ensure that there are no nuts, sweets or uncut fruit in your child's lunchbox. We
 have some serious allergies within the school, and we follow the same food policy as
 main school.
- Please remember that we are no longer allow to message via Dojo. If you need to
 contact us to leave quick information (i.e. change in pick up), you can leave a message
 but please do not expect a reply. If you need a reply, please contact the school via email
 or phone and it will be redirected to the nursery.
- We are also reiterating that children should not be playing or riding their scooters/bikes on the road alongside forest school. This is a private road and cars need permanent access. It is dangerous, so please keep your children safe and in sight.
- Our nursery doorbell is for nursery use only. It only works during the school day (8:50-3:30) is switched off outside of school hours.
