Welcome to a very busy second Spring half-term! There is a lot happening this half-term as we prepare for World Book Day, Mother's Day and, of course, Easter.

Cooking and baking will take place every other week for this half term, starting in week 2, and a Dojo will be sent out in advance for any allergies to be taken in consideration. Donations towards this are always welcome but never expected.

PE for the half term will take place in the main school hall on a Thursday morning, so we ask that your children come in comfy shoes and either leggings or trousers for this day. We may be using the apparatus during these sessions, so please refrain from putting on tights if possible.

Although the weather is seemingly improving, we are still cautious that cold snaps are becoming more and more apparent. We still highly recommend that warm coats are worn to school, and hats and gloves where needed. Spares are available in nursery.
