SCIENCE: Everyday Materials

In this unit about Everyday Materials the children will distinguish between an object and the material, identity and name a variety of everyday materials based on which material they are made of, describe the simple physical properties of everyday materials, perform simple tests to identify some properties, classify materials into groups and make simple comparisons of materials.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times? In this unit, the children will explore the meaning of celebrating. They will explore festivals such as Harvest and Diwali as well as exploring the significance of Christmas for Christians and the Christmas story.

All the learning is focused around practise for the school Nativity with Key Stage One. They will learn songs that are in the show and identify the instruments within the songs and learn how to sing as a chorus. GEOGRAPHY

In this unit, the children will learn about their immediate environment. They will explore their school environment using first-hand observation and experience to enhance their awareness along with essential map skills and fieldwork. They will recognise familiar landmarks in their environment. They will use maps and plan routes. They will us simple fieldwork and make simple observations about the school and area,

ART

In this unit, children will make a collage with autumn materials. They will use different materials to create Autumn artwork such as pencils, clay and paints.

COMPUTING

We are Treasure Hunters

In this unit, pupils learn basic programming ideas through experimenting and solving problems with simple, programmable robots.. They will control a programmable robot by inputting data and creating algorithms.
