I hope you have had a restful and enjoyable half-term holiday.

This half-term sees us enjoying all sorts of exciting topics. Our main theme is - Our wonderful world. We will have a visit from our local library team, to help us find out more about caring for the environment, our impact- littering etc and the positive changes that we can make, even as 6 and 7 year olds.

We will learn about the 7 continents and the major oceans and seas around our world. We will look at the hot and cold climates, the animals and vegetation within each and consider how humans cope in extreme environments.

Through our focus book-Emma Jane's aeroplane, we will fly around the world and meet and travel with all manner of animal passengers, through all kinds of weather. In English, we will write our own version of the story and will learn about and begin to use new grammatical features: adverbs, contracted and possessive apostrophes and synonyms. Our use of dictionaries will increase as an aid to checking, editing and improving our own work. We will produce a persuasive piece of text towards the end of the term about how to look after our wonderful world.

In Religious Education, we will learn about a wide range of festivals, celebrated by a range of religions and will consider the big question of why do we celebrate special times.
