

Communication and Language

- \rightarrow Chatterbags (autumn foliage)
- → Be able to talk about familiar stories with varying detail
- → Begin to understand 'why' questions
- → Singing well known nursery rhymes with increased confidence and independence
- → Learning Christmas songs for nativity / assembly
- \rightarrow Listening to longer stories
- → Early Talk Boost (intervention group)

Mathematics

- → Comparing amounts saying 'more than', 'fewer than' or 'same'
- → Linking numerals to amounts (physical and visual) up to 5
- → Talk about and notice patterns around them
- → Understanding position through words alone
- → Take part in finger rhymes with numbers to 10

Personal, Social and Emotional Development


- → Remembering the nursery routine
- Remembering the nursery rules without needing an adult to remind them
- → Showing more confidence in social situations
- → Sharing and finding solutions to conflicts/rivalries
- ightarrow Selecting appropriate resources

Physical Development


- → Gross motor skills developing movement skills
- → Ball skills kicking, throwing and catching
- → Fine motor skills pencil control and hand-held tools
- → Using large and small motor skills to gain independence - managing zips, buttons, pouring drinks, etc.
- → Playdough disco

Literacy

- → Name recognition and writing activities
- → Level 1 phonics activities large and small groups (aspects 7-12)
- → Level 2 SATPIN sounds (HA but all introduced)
- → Nursery rhyme bag
- ightarrow Library time
- → Letter recognition and early sound recognition
- → Communication activities and home links Chatterbags
- → Recognising words with the same initial sounds
