Dear parent/carer,

Firstly, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support with everything in school. Without your help and support with things like homework, weekly reading and spellings the children wouldn't have been able to make the progress that they have. Thank you! The weeks ahead leading to Easter look set to be another busy period in school. Our new topic in school is 'Food, Glorious Food!'.
